Play Your Part

- Remember – Kids Play for FUN!
- Applaud effort & good play – not just success
- Respect the referee's decisions – even if you disagree
- Appreciate good play – from both teams
- Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area
- Let coaches do their job – avoid confusing players with extra instructions
- Encourage respect – towards opponents, referees, and match officials
- Support positively – mistakes are learning moments, offer encouragement not criticism
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, abusive, or insulting language or behaviour

Consequences of Not Following the Code

If the Code is not followed, any of the following actions may be taken by the club, County FA, or The FA:

-  Verbal warning from a club or league official
-  Meeting required with the club, league, or CFA Welfare Officer
-  Meeting with the club committee
-  Completion of an FA education course
-  Obligated to leave the match venue
-  Restricted from attending future games
-  Suspension or removal of club membership (including dependents)
-  Fines and/or suspension imposed on the club by The FA/County FA
